Tailored for you

We recognise that every organisation has different needs, and different levels of knowledge about LGBT issues amongst its staff.

We will work with you to design a training package that will enable your staff to actively listen, participate, absorb, practice and reflect on the information we provide.

Trans* is an umbrella term used by people whose gender identity and/or gender expression differs from their birth sex. The term includes, but is not limited to, transsexual people and others who define as gender-variant

What do you want to learn?

We place lesbian, gay, bisexual and trans* people at the centre of our training.

You may want the focus on a particular section of the community.

You might, for example, only work with one gender or you might need exposure to all sexual orientations and gender identities.

Our training can be tailored for different audiences:

- policy level, including department heads, CEOs.

Your course

Courses usually run from 10.00am to 4.30pm, with a break for lunch. We are also able to provide half-day training sessions or shorter workshops. These can also be offered at weekends or in the evening subject to trainer availability.

Our head office is based in London but we are able to accommodate requests for training in all areas of the UK. Travel costs and expenses will be added as an additional item to your final quote.

DISCUSS YOUR PACKAGE

Your package

Each training package includes set modules and bespoke options designed to best suit the needs of your organisation. We recommend training groups of between 8 and 20 people to retain the best learning environment, but if you need training for more people, we can discuss how this can be done cost effectively.

Once training has been agreed, we ask you to circulate a pre-training questionnaire to staff members booked to attend the day. This helps our trainers gauge knowledge levels and expertise within the group and gives further opportunity to target the training needs.

Our training style

Trainers can use a range of tools, including case studies, presentations, quizzes, role play, visual games, reflective exercises, and anecdotal evidence, multi-media, research and homework.

We can discuss the types of training that best suit your organisation.

Our training is designed to be challenging yet welcoming, to ensure that the learning environment is respectful to all participants. We ask all delegates attending our training to sign up to ground rules to ensure all participants are able to get the most out of their time.
